Drumming Circle: Join others in the church chapel from 5:30-6:30 pm the **third and fourth Mondays** of the month for drum prayer (see dates below). 11 hand drums are available, first come, first to choose. ### ALY SUMMER SACK LUNCH PROGRAM

At this writing, plans for ALY Summer Lunches are a few days from final, but we hope our faithful volunteers will be thinking about the calendar, and will save some dates to help pack and deliver lunches in July and August. The program starts on Tuesday, July 9th, and runs each Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday until August 15th.

At least six volunteers are needed each day, with 2 drivers and 2 riders taking care of deliveries. These delivery teams can be part of the food prep group, or can be volunteers who only want to deliver.

Meal prep will begin at 10:00 each day, with delivery teams scheduled to leave by 11:20. There are four off-premises sites, Fairview Mobile Home Ct., St. Patrick's school parking lot, Strawberry Hill Apartment complex, and Fawn Creek Mobile Home Ct., in addition to the Lawrence Community Center home base.

Your St. Paul team of Sally Clapp, Virginia Danielson, and Ed Gerst will be responsible for a certain day, but volunteers are invited to sign up for work on any of the scheduled days.
